The following is a review of the custodial and other services provided to Tanglewood:

Routine Cleaning

The Housekeeping Department is responsible for the general cleaning of Tanglewood with the exception of the second floor areas which serve as the President's personal residence. Most of the service is provided to the first floor which regularly is used for official University business.

Routine cleaning requires the service of one custodial worker for a total of twelve hours per week.

Special Events

The Housekeeping Department and occasionally the Logistics and/or Grounds Departments provide set-up/take-down and cleaning services as required for University sponsored special functions.

Overnight Guests

The Housekeeping Department provides cleaning services (including linen) for the second and third floor guest bedrooms and bathrooms for overnight guests on University business.

Grounds

Tanglewood is provided with normal routine services (i.e., grass cutting, snow removal, trash pick-up, etc.) on a scheduled basis similar to other University property.

Repairs and General Maintenance

The Physical Plant Division responds to work orders for Tanglewood as required.
