During her twenty years at West Chester University, Dr. Cleary served in many different capacities on various campus and department committees. She made important scholarly contributions to the profession of teacher education, was counselor to many students, served the Community Music School and was faculty advisor to the Women's Service Sorority (Alpha Phi International Sorority). Her personal qualities have endeared her to her students, colleagues and teachers.

Philip P. Hoggard 1968 - 1983

Dr. Hoggard has made contributions in all areas of academic, professional, and student life at West Chester University. He was founder of the Zeta Psi Chapter of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity - the first predominately Black fraternity on campus. He also spent time in England on a Fulbright exchange. From this and other experiences he brought to the University a richness in inter-cultural and international experiences. He served with distinction on various campus committees and was a mentor to both students and faculty during his involvement in Teacher Education.

Jane E. Sheppard 1953 - 1987

During her thirty four years as a member of the School of Music, Ms. Sheppard made major contributions to the University and to her field of specialization. She organized and was a part of many performances and music festivals involving faculty and students at West Chester University and elsewhere. Her students have won many awards in vocal and choral conducting and have been accepted in advanced performance programs at prestigious music schools. She was one of the first recipients of the University's Faculty Merit Award in Recognition of Teaching Excellence.

Edwin L. Youmans 1960 - 1986

Dr. Youmans served as a leader in the coaching field and dedicated many years to coaching track and field, as well as performing his normal teaching duties. In addition to his long tenure as Graduate Coordinator in the Department of Physical Education, Dr. Youmans also served as Dean of the School of Health and Physical Education. He also played a key part in the development of the South Campus Complex, which was a monumental task.
